

IMMEDIATE RESPONSE FOR ACCIDENT, INJURY OR ILLNESS

Accidents should be responded to by the first person on the scene.

Call a cease fire if the injured is near the firing line or downrange.

Be sure that all firearms are unloaded and in a safe condition.

Notify EMS: CALL 911 and provide the following information.

**The Exact location of the injured on the property
Condition of the injured or ill
Number of people injured or ill
What happened and possible hazards for the EMS personnel
First Aid provided if any so far
Your name and the phone number you are calling from**

Wait for EMS to hang up first. Return to the injured and continue care until EMS Arrive.

**Move the injured only if life is endangered
Check the injured for life threatening condition before providing care
Provide care only within your level of training
Never provide medications unless directed by EMS personnel
First Aid Kit and Automated External Defibrillator located in clubhouse near restrooms**

EMS can activate the gate by the SOS System installed. This is a Siren Operated Sensor that will open the gate. The EMS departments have all been notified of this system. But if possible, send someone to ensure the gate opens and help direct EMS personnel to the injured.

**Assist EMS personnel as needed
If the accident involves a firearm injury, notify the police and preserve the scene
Collect the names and phone numbers of any witnesses
Notify the Executive Range Officer or another member on the Board of Directors
Preserve the scene of the accident until the Executive Range Officer or a member of the Board of Directors arrive**
