KEEP IT SAFE

ALWAYS keep firearms pointed in a safe direction. **ALWAYS** keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.

ALWAYS keep firearms unloaded until ready to use.
ALWAYS unload, remove the magazine, and open the action of a firearm when someone is going down range.

NEVER handle firearms while someone is down range.
ALWAYS wear proper eye and ear protection at the range.

DMSC Conducts Safety Reviews

Range Safety Officers (RSOs) will conduct random membership checks and safety reviews. RSOs will meet with members and guests while at the firing range. Membership ID's will be checked and a copy of the range rules will be made available. It's important for all members to review safe gun handling procedures and to focus on the safety rules for each range used. The RSOs will be a wearing a distinctive safety vest or hat and will only ask for a few minutes of your time. Guests and Visitors are subject to the same rules as members. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from club grounds and termination of membership.

Resolution of the Board Of Directors

Resolved:

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors of the Dormont-Mt. Lebanon Sportsmen's Club held on March 14, 2019, the Board approved by a majority vote to accept the following modifications to the By-Laws of the Club which were Adopted on February 26, 2004 (Modified on 23 June 2011 and 8 November 2107) and to recommend, in accordance with the procedures stipulated in the By-Laws, to the membership for adoption of the following changes:

1. Change in the requirement for Life Membership.

The proposed change to the By-Laws is to change the requirement for life membership to require a minimum of 10 years of continuous membership before accepting applications for Life Membership. Section 2.5 currently reads:

Section 2.5 <u>Life Member</u>. Any Active Member may become a Life Member by an advance payment of an amount to be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors and shall thereafter be exempt from annual dues. A Life Member shall have full voting rights at any Club meeting and shall be eligible to hold any Club office. At the discretion of the Board of Directors, an individual may be proposed for an Awarded Life Membership. Publication of such intent shall be made in the Sportsmen's Notes for two consecutive months. Thereafter, at the next regular meeting of Members, a vote on the proposal shall be taken, and the affirmative vote of a majority of Members in attendance shall constitute approval.

The proposed change to Section 2.5 is as follows:

Section 2.5 <u>Life Member</u>. Any Active **or Senior** Member **who has been a member in good standing for a minimum of ten (10) continuous years,** may become a Life Member by an advance payment of an amount to be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors and shall thereafter be exempt from annual dues. A Life Member shall have full voting rights at any Club meeting and shall be eligible to hold any Club office.

At the discretion of the Board of Directors, an individual may be proposed for an Awarded Life Membership. Publication of such intent shall be made in the Sportsmen's Notes for two consecutive months. Thereafter, at the next regular meeting of Members, a vote on the proposal shall be taken, and the affirmative vote of a majority of Members in attendance shall constitute approval.
